Low-cost health care is available to EVERYONE for \$45.00 for basic office visits. Labs and special procedures are extra. There is no prequalification necessary.

## HOW CAN I GET FREE HEALTH CARE?

Patients may go to our website and click on the patient instruction page to prequalify by simply answering a few questions. You will be notified of your status usually within 24-48 hours. You may then come to the next Eligibility Registration at one of the appointed times listed on the website.
