Successful proposals will meet the following criteria:

- Strengthens academics;
- Demonstrates a creative and innovative approach to education;
- Provides meaningful and engaging instruction for students;
- Is well thought-out with a long-term benefit;
- Incorporates budget details; and,
- Includes the official application completed in its entirety.

Who may apply:

- CCSD teachers, paraprofessionals and school staff;
- Teams of CCSD teachers, paraprofessionals and school staff;
- CCSD administrators; and,
- CCSD department heads.

To apply: Please complete the attached Application Form and submit with your grant narrative. Applications must be 12 pt. Times New Roman, Calibri, Arial or Lato font, and no more than four pages. - 6. Communication: Explain how you will share the outcomes of your project with colleagues and community. (15 points)
