

Donations

It shall be the policy of the Cherokee County Board of Education (“Board”) to accept or deny donations from any source. Upon acceptance by the Board, all donations shall become the property of the Cherokee County Board of Education. It shall also be the policy of the Board to encourage donations from any legitimate sources, including booster clubs. However, in order to assist the school system in maintaining compliance with the Georgia Equity in Sports Act, any donations made to athletic programs of the school system and accepted by the Board must be accompanied by either a valuation of such donation or an accounting of actual costs incurred by the donor regarding the donations. The Superintendent shall establish criteria for the evaluation of offers and acceptance of donations to the school system. Donations may include real or personal property donated, as well as donations of services. The Board shall only consider receipts of donations that conform to state and federal laws and to policies of the Board, including but not limited to, any applicable safety standards.
