

School Equipment and Supplies

The purchase of equipment and supplies for use in the schools should first be approved by the Superintendent or designee. Central purchasing should be done when it is advantageous and feasible.

When all other factors are equal, purchases should be made locally.

The Board has the responsibility to assure that all purchases are made in the best interest of the district both as to the quality and usefulness of the purchases in meeting program goals and as to economy and efficiency. Therefore, the Board shall authorize the purchasing of all materials, goods, services and supplies for the school system in accordance with state law and good purchasing practices.
