

BOARD POLICY
Student Transportation Management

Descriptor Code: ED

It is the policy of the Cherokee County Board of Education to provide transportation to all eligible students who reside in the system. The district will acquire, maintain, and operate such vehicles as the Board deems necessary for the efficient operation of the schools. The district shall seek to assure the safety of all children who are provided district transportation. The district will comply with all Federal, State and local laws and regulations pertaining to student transportation.

It is recognized that bus transportation is a privilege provided as a service of the Cherokee County Board of Education and that this privilege can be withdrawn due to violations of the code of conduct.

The primary use of school buses is to transport students to school and/or school related functions. However, under certain circumstances, certain organizations with permission or partnership agreements may be authorized to lease school buses.

The Superintendent shall establish guidelines and rules necessary to provide for implementation of this policy.
