

Bus Drivers

To be considered for continued employment for any ensuing school term it shall be mandatory that the driver pass the annual medical examination prescribed by the State Board of Education not more than 30 days before the beginning of the school term, and as often thereafter as the county system Board of Education may deem it necessary.

Beginning January 1, 1995, all persons who drive a school bus for the Cherokee County Board of Education must participate in random drug and alcohol screening as required under federal laws and regulations and as further detailed in state and local board of education policies.
