

Instructional Resources Selection and Adoption

Instructional Resources (textbooks, software, supplemental materials), as defined by the State Board of Education, will be selected by a committee appointed by the Superintendent, consisting of district-level staff, school administrators, teachers, instructional support personnel and parent/community representatives.

The primary goal of the committee will be to assure that all instructional resources are thoroughly evaluated for the highest degree of accuracy, quality, and alignment with the School District Standards and the student performance standards as approved by the State Board of Education prior to submission to the Superintendent for recommendation to the School Board for adoption.

Instructional resource adoptions will be considered from listings prescribed by the State Board of Education. The School District may continue use of adopted resources, provided that any new resources purchased subsequent to the State adoption of new instructional resources are purchased from the most recent listing.

A process for review of the proposed instructional materials will be made available by the School District upon stakeholders' requests. Instructional resource adoptions will be within the framework of the State Board of Education requirements.
